



Dalia Jatautaitė – organ

Dalia Jatautaitė, an organ player, started playing the piano at the age of 6. In 1983 she graduated from the Music Academy as a specialist of both the piano and the organ. After graduating, Ms Jatautaitė took part in numerous master courses conducted by the most famous organists in the world. In 1995 she graduated with honours from the higher studies of church music (Professor E. Triebel) in Graz (Austria). Dalia Jatautaitė goes on concert Tours on Lithuania and many European countries, USA, Canada, Philippines, Russia. She made many recorded recordings by Radio Lithuanian. Currently, D. Jatautaitė conducts organ classes at the Kaunas Conservatory, she is the head of the Music Center Church. In the repertoire of the organist, Lithuanian holds a very important place organ music. On the occasion of the jubilee anniversary of the 600th anniversary of the city of Kaunas, D. Jatautaitė recorded a CD on the historical organs of the St. Peter in Kaunas.
